SEEKING GOD IN 2024

The last few years have been important for **rockypc** as we've spent significant amounts of time working out what it means for us to be GROWING DISCIPLES WHO SACRIFICE, SERVE & SPEAK FOR THE SAKE OF OTHERS. In 2021, we introduced our FIVE CORE VALUES which express what we'll focus on to ensure we keep growing. Since then, each year, we've considered how we can develop one of those CORE VALUES in our congregations, for the glory of Jesus in our city — SERVE (2022) and COMMUNITY (2023).

In 2024, our focus will be on what it means to SEEK GOD, because we want to remember that as we get DEEP IN THE WORD it's not simply about information in, but GOD'S WORD CALLS FOR A RESPONSE. We SEEK GOD by responding appropriately — as our understanding of God grows, so will our love for him: we'll praise him more; we'll have hearts filled with thanksgiving for all his generosity and goodness towards us; but we'll also be moved to lament, confession, humble repentance and a growing dependence on God in every situation. Our response to God will shape how we SERVE and engage in MISSION, all in COMMUNITY together.

Over four weeks, this VISION SERIES will consider more deeply how SEEKING GOD is linked to each of the other CORE VALUES. The GROWTH GROUP STUDIES will run before the sermon in order to get us thinking about the relationships that exist and hopefully form some meaningful connections for everyone.

GROWTH GROUP STUDY — HEBREWS

How do you like to say 'thank you' — Words? Card? Gift? Something else? Today we're going to spend some time thinking about God's Word and how we should respond to it, from the book of Hebrews. We'll see how our core value of being DEEP IN THE WORD leads us to our value of SEEKING GOD. **READ HEBREWS 1v1-4** 1. How did God speak in the past? Can you think of examples of the various ways? 2. How has God spoken in the last chapter of history? 3. Given all of this, what makes the Bible so special and important to listen to? **READ HEBREWS 3v7-14** Upon hearing God's voice, a whole generation of Israelites didn't enter the rest of the Promised Land. 4. What is the attitude to God's Word that we are in danger of copying? 5. How can we cultivate a different response to His Word? **READ HEBREWS 4v12-16** 6. What is God's Word like? What does it do to our hearts? 7. When God's Word cuts us to the heart, where should we turn? What confidence can we have to do this?

growing disciples

At **rockypc** we have 5 core values — we want to be growing disciples who are DEEP IN THE WORD, SEEKING GOD, on MISSION, as we SERVE in COMMUNITY together.

Looking back over the past week, what have your thoughts and actions shown about your attitude to God's word?

How has his word been cutting you to the heart today? How will you respond? Are you confident in God's mercy as you turn to him?

DEEP IN THE WORD

Is **rockypc** a COMMUNITY that is DEEP IN THE WORD together? How can we help one another to respond to God's word with soft hearts, repentance and praise?

COMMUNITY

Theologian, Dr J I Packer, said 'The purpose of theology is doxology.' In other words, we study and learn things about God so that we can praise him.

To do that, you could choose a song or 2 to listen to from YouTube (or sing, if you're feeling brave) or you could read Psalm 96

SEEKING GOD

- Praise God as the living, speaking God. Praise him for speaking to us through Jesus, his majestic Son. Thank him for his word, the Bible so we can know him and hear his voice.
- Thank him that his word sees right into our hearts and exposes every hidden thing. Confess when your heart has been sinful and unbelieving, turning away from God. Turn to him in repentance. Confidently approach his throne of grace to find mercy, grace and help because of our great high priest, the Son of God. Ask his help to hold firmly to the faith we profess.
- Pray that we'd encourage one another daily, as long as it is called today, that none of us would be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. Ask for God's Spirit to strengthen us so that we'd hold our conviction to the end, sharing in Christ.
- Ask that we would have eyes to see the joyful assembly that we are part of now in the heavenly Jerusalem, praising the living God, the Judge of all and Jesus, our mediator.
- Since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, pray that we'd be thankful, worshiping God with reverence and awe. Pray that our lips would continually offer a sacrifice of praise, professing Jesus' name because he suffered to make us holy. Pray that we'd respond with good works that please our Father.

GROWTH GROUP STUDY — 1 PETER

Name a beautiful building. What do you admire about it? What is the purpose of the building?

Last week we looked at the book of Hebrews to see how God speaks to us in His Word. So we want to get DEEP IN THE WORD and respond by SEEKING HIM with soft hearts, full of praise. Today we are looking at the book of 1 Peter to see the way Jesus forms us into a COMMUNITY who SEEK HIM together.

How is **rockypc** declaring the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light, as a COMMUNITY? Loving each other deeply from the heart? Praying? Standing firm together? Leading and submitting?

- Praise God that we've been purchased with the precious blood of Christ. Through him we believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, so our faith and hope are in God. Praise him that we've been born again through the living and enduring word of God.
- Thank him for building us into a spiritual house together, on Jesus, the cornerstone. Praise him for making us his chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, his special possession.
- Pray that our **rockypc** COMMUNITY would declare the praises of him who called us out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once we were not a people, but now we're the people of God who have received his mercy.
- Confess when we've had too low a view of church in God's purposes. Pray that we'd glorify him by loving one another deeply from the heart.
- Ask that God's Spirit would draw us to prayerfully and humbly depend on our Father in prayer.
- Pray that we'd stand firm together as his family in suffering an that even that would be opportunity for God's praise. Ask that the shape of our COMMUNITY, with leading and submitting, would help us to SEEK HIM and his honour together.

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SEEKING GOD

- Praise God for sending Jesus to give his life as a ransom for many, that he went to the cross as a sacrifice to show us his mercy. Pray that we would be disciples who are like our master. That we'd deny ourselves and follow him.
- Pray that we'd respond to Jesus' love by loving others. Confess when we've failed to SERVE others, or done so without humility or generosity. Ask that we'd SERVE one another as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God, with joy, patience and faith.
- Pray that as we SERVE, we'd lead others to SEEK GOD too. That we'd help others grow as disciples and grow new disciples. Ask for God's wisdom to know how to SERVE at **rockypc**.

GROWTH GROUP STUDY —1&2 THESSALONIANS

Have you ever seen someone else become a Christian, and played a part in the process? Tell us about what it was like.
Throughout our vision series we've looked at how we SEEK GOD in response to his WORD; how we're a COMMUNITY who SEEK HIM and our response of SERVING like the Son of Man who served us. Today, we'll see how the gospel transforms us, so that we're on MISSION to our world. READ 1 THESSALONIANS 1v2-10 1. How did the gospel of Jesus work powerfully in the lives of these people?
2. What effect did this have, even beyond their own city? v7-10
READ 1 THESSALONIANS 2v1-12 3. What motivated Paul to tell the gospel despite strong opposition? (see Acts 16 for the story of false charges, beating, flogging and imprisonment that Paul endured in Philippi)
4. What do you notice about the way Paul shared the gospel?
5. Describe the relationship between the gospel message and the lives/actions of those who tell it.
READ 1 THESSALONIANS 4v13-5v11 6. What hope do we have in Jesus?
7. How does our hope differ from the beliefs of the rest of mankind?

8. How should we live, in view of the coming day?

READ 2 THESSALONIANS 3v1-5

9. What does Paul want the Thessalonians to pray about?

10. How does God's character give hope and certainty, despite opposition to the message?

Paul said he shared both the gospel and his life with the Thessalonians. Are you more likely to love without words or speak without love? How can you grow to be more like a gentle mother or an encouraging, urging father to those in your life who aren't part of Jesus' kingdom yet?

What purpose is there in praying for your friends and family to put their hope in Jesus?



At **rockypc**, we're praying for God to give 8000 new people to Jesus in Rockhampton and Gracemere in our generation, just for a start, because we want to reach the 80,000. We want to pray on this big scale, but also for particular people in our lives. Take a 5 4 JESUS card now. Spend a few minutes reading it and think of 5 people who you will commit to praying for over the next 12 months. Then spend some time praying together.

- Praise God that Jesus died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with him. Praise him for the hope we have that Jesus will return and we'll live with him forever. Thank him for his power that turned you from idols to serve the living God.
- Pray that our faith would ring out in our city. That we'd love others and share our lives with them. And that we'd speak the gospel with sincerity and kindness, even when there's opposition.
- Confess your lack of prayer for those who aren't yet saved, and your lack of confidence in God to be at work in them. Ask his help to diligently SEEK HIM, asking his help to share the gospel and our lives.
- Pray for God to give 8000 new people to Jesus in Rockhampton and Gracemere in our generation, just for a start. Pray for 5 friends and family members to know Jesus' salvation.
